- Where applicable, materials lists will be supplied at the time of booking. In some cases basic consumables are supplied. Any additional materials must be purchased by the course participant at local art suppliers or from the gallery shop.
- Due to OH&S issues, all participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the course, especially if damage to clothing is a concern. Participants will not be allowed to enter a class wearing thongs or open-toed footwear.
